Preschool – 4 year old program

Saint Ann and Our Lady of the Assumption

Program and Hours

The Preschool curriculum is focused on developing social, listening and self-help skills. The 4 year old preschool programs are offered at Our Lady of the Assumption and Saint Ann Catholic Schools. They are dedicated to providing a Christ-centered community that creates a family atmosphere that is uniquely warm and welcoming. The program will run Monday through Friday from 7:45 am – 2:45 pm for the full day program and 7:45 am – noon for the half-day program. The school calendar for preschool will follow the MACS school calendar.

Application Procedures

Applications for enrollment in MACS Preschool program will be accepted beginning January 4, 2010. Applications will be available on line at www.charlottediocese.org in mid December. Admissions will continue until all seats are filled. Student will be interviewed by the school principal prior to acceptance. You will receive a phone call to schedule the interview. **An application and screening process is necessary for entry into the MACS kindergarten programs for the following school year.**

Parents or guardians should submit the completed PK application to the MACS Admission Office. Each completed application should be accompanied by a \$25 (per student) non-refundable application fee. Checks are to be made payable to MACS. A copy of the applicant's birth certificate and health and immunization records should be included with the completed application and application fee.

Requirements

A child must be 4 years of age on or before August 31, 2010 to qualify for placement in the PK program for the 2010-2011 school year. The child's age must be verified by a birth certificate.

All schools in the Diocese of Charlotte admit students of any race, color, sex, religion, national and ethnic origin to all the programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at these schools.

2010-2011 Tuition and Fees

There is a \$25 application fee (due with application). A \$75 registration fee is due upon acceptance into the program.

School Year 2010-2011**

All students are required by NC General Statute 130A-154 to have the following immunizations in order to attend school (all public and private schools)

- 1. DTP/DTaP – 5 doses**
- 2. Tdap booster prior to entering the 6th grade if it has been 5 years or greater since the last DTP/DTap**
- 3. Polio – 4 doses**
- 4. Hib – 1 dose (cannot be administered after age 5)**
- 5. Hepatitis B – 3 doses**
- 6. Varicella – 1 dose**
- 7. Measles – 2 doses**
- 8. Mumps – 2 doses**
- 9. Rubella – 1 dose**

The above requirements are applied for certain age groups and whether or not immunizations began as an infant. The school nurse reviews these requirements on an individual basis as each student is enrolled.

Parents must provide the immunization certificate to school. The immunization certificate may be copied. The original certificate should be retained by the family (and updated as booster doses are received) throughout the child's school career extending through college.

Immunization Certificates presented to school must include:

1. Name of child, birth date, address and names of parent/.guardian.
2. Full dates of each immunization dose (month, day, year)
3. Name and address of physician or clinic which administered the immunizations.
4. Certificates are to be signed or stamped by the physician or clinic.

St. Ann Catholic School Profile 2009-2010



St. Ann Catholic School was founded in 1955 and staffed by the Sisters of St. Joseph and lay teachers. The original school was opened with 12 classrooms and a cafeteria. In 1960, 6 additional classrooms and a library opened. In 1993, a new gymnasium, cafeteria, and 2 playgrounds opened. Our students use the science, art and computer labs and the all purpose room. Classrooms are equipped with closed circuit TVs, SmartBoards, and a teacher resource center is now available. A Weather Station is in full operation and monitored by students. Read Naturally, Empowered Writes and Study Island programs are in place. In 07-08 a new program of Speech/Language Stimulation was implemented for students with special learning needs.
