Descriptions of Activities
For Easter Break 2010

MACS Discovery Days offers a variety of activities for **Kindergarten through fifth graders** during the school year for most days when school is not in session. This registration form and your tuition must be dropped off at the MACS Education Office or received by mail by the indicated date below. **DO NOT turn in registrations to your school office or to the after school program. Registrations received at the MACS Office after the indicated registration deadline will automatically be placed on a waiting list and will be accepted ONLY IF staff : child ratios allow.** Late registrations will be notified promptly by phone for space availability. **Because supplies, activities, and staffing are dependent upon registration numbers, we do not accept drop-ins.** Your child will receive a Discovery Day T-shirt on his/her first Discovery Day. Additional T-shirts may be purchased for \$10. Please pack a bagged lunch, (2) snacks and drinks for your child. Please dress your child in comfortable play clothes and sneakers (no sandals, flip flops, etc.). Discovery Day registration forms will be found in the Thursday packets and on-line at www.charlottediocese.org/programs. Registration will take place one month prior to each month's Discovery Days.

Tues., April 6, 2010: Mrs. Hanes' Moravian Cookies - Clemmons, NC

Mrs. Hanes' is one of the few remaining Moravian bakeries that still make all their cookies by hand. We will tour the family owned bakery where we will learn not only how the cookies are made but also how math, economics, writing skills and history play a part in running a successful business. Each child will receive 6 cookie samples and will have an opportunity to buy cookies to bring home. Let me know if you'd like a price list in advance.

Wed., April 7, 2010: Carolinas Aviation Museum - Charlotte, NC

Join us as we have a personal guided tour of the aviation museum. Students will visit the interactive KC-97 and F-4 Phantom Cockpits, view historic aircraft, artifacts and learn about NC aviation history. The museum is located at the end of one of Charlotte Douglas Airport's runways, so we should see some exciting take offs and landings as well.

Thurs., April 8, 2010: Reedy Creek Nature Center – Charlotte, NC

On this trip to Reedy Creek Nature Center we will participate in the Seeds for Sowing program. Our younger students will learn about seeds, big ones, small ones, round ones, long ones, how they travel and the journey they take to become a new plant. Our older students will dissect flowers in addition to learning about seeds.

Fri., April 9, 2010: Fort Dobbs, Statesville, NC

Fort Dobbs is NC's only French and Indian War fort site still in existence. We will travel back in time to the year 1760 where we will learn about the lives and events of NC settlers, Indians, and soldiers during the Great War for Empire between England and France. Hands-on activity stations include: powder horn making, woodworking, transportation, cooking, 18th century games, military drill, and much more. We traveled to Fort Dobbs last year and found this event to be very educational and a lot of fun. In my opinion, hands-on, experiential, fun activities are the best way to learn and retain what you have learned.
